

for Violin, Double Bass and Voice





this piece comprises of a set of "suspended dream scenes"
 the music arising is fragile, quiet, static and without "development"
 15 pages with a text plus graphical and conventional notation are given
 a performance should start and end with the first page: "missing"
 in between this, the players have a free choice of which pages to play
 some of the notation should be played precisely, as indicated
 other parts of the notation have more space for free interpretation

guide for the graphical notation:

○ = sing/hum - voice should be quite
 indistinct and blend with the bowed
 string sound, generally "singing"
 quietly with a half-open mouth -
 somewhere between humming and
 regular singing works best

when amplification is available:
 close microphones can be used to
 amplify the voices - sending the
 signal through a very long
 reverb to create a "hovering choir"
 of voices (always p - mp in dynamics
 and never louder than the strings)



the string plays a slow glissando from
 a sharp (#) note to a natural (n) note, moving
 carefully between the micro-intervals, the voice
 tries to find and sustain the in-between tone
 indicated ...

where no specific note is indicated - the choice
 is free for the player

accidentals notation:

= sharp ; # = flat sharp ; # = sharp natural ; # = natural
 b = flat ; b = sharp flat ; b = flat natural
 ## = sharp sharp ; b# = sharp flat ; b# = flat flat etc...

other notation is either conventionally written/played
 or otherwise open to free interpretation




